Rules for using laboratories

1. Opening hours

From 08:00 until 21:00 on weekdays only

2. Check your health

First of all, please check your own health, and if you feel any concern about your health, please avoid using laboratories on that day. Please be careful with this point.

3. Avoid three Cs: "Closed spaces", "Crowded places", "Close-contact settings".

The capacity of each laboratory is less than the half of the original capacity. Please do not have lunch at laboratories.

To avoid three Cs, all master course students are asked to make a registration online in advance.

Moreover, the opening hours are divided into two parts; AM (from 08:00 until 13:00) and PM (from 13:00 until 21:00). If there are sufficient vacancy, you may book slots both in AM and in PM on the same day. And from a technical reason, registrations can be made up to 7 days in advance.

As for doctoral course students, please talk among students and arrange how to manage. And please use disinfection liquid to wipe desks and tables.

4. Disinfection liquid for desks and tables

Bottles of disinfection liquid will be prepared on each laboratory for master course students and also in front of lecture rooms (2F in Math Dept Bldg and 8F in Science Complex A Bldg).

5. Air the room

Please air the room by keeping windows and doors (moderately) open, when you are there.

6. Wearing face masks and wash your hands

Please wear face masks in laboratories. And wash your hands when you arrive at/leave from a laboratory. You may find a bottle of hand-washing in each laboratory.

7. Do not eat and drink

Please do not eat and drink anything in laboratories. However, bottles with caps are admissible to drink. And please do never use tableware (e.g., cups and glasses) furnished in each laboratory.

8. Please do not talk loudly and avoid excessive chatting

9. Registration for entering/leaving

When you arrive at a laboratory, please make a registration at the following site:



10. In the event of a disaster

11. Refilling up hand-wash

When the hand-wash at your laboratory runs short, please refill it at secretary offices on the 1F of Math Bldg or on the 7F of Science Complex A Bldg (please ask someone there during opening hours).

12. Please do not use garbage boxes

Please throw your rubbish directly to a garbage box on the corridor near the laboratory and never throw it to garbage boxes in laboratories.
